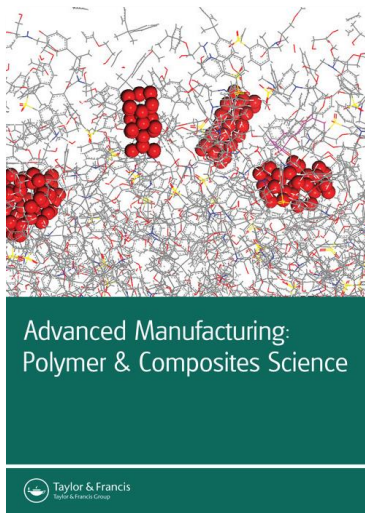
International Journals
